1. Roll-Off Rules

- a. To determine the teams that will be moving forward to the tournament Roll-Off the following criteria will be followed:
 - i. The team pin count will be a total of pin fall to include handicaps
 1. Teams with the highest pin fall count
- b. After all registered and participating have completed all four games a total of 10 teams will advance to the tournament's Roll-Off. There will be two Bowling Shifts (A Shift and B Shift) and each shift will have teams representing based on the following team entries:
 - i. 1-5 teams bowling = 1 team advancing
 - ii. 6-10 teams bowling = 2 teams advancing
 - iii. 11-15 teams bowling = 3 teams advancing
 - iv. 16-19 teams bowling = 4 teams advancing
 - v. 20+ teams will have equal teams in the Roll-Off
- c. In the event that the tournament falls below 20 teams or there is only one shift bowling the tournament director can alter the numbers of teams advancing.
- d. Top 4 teams with the highest pin counts in the Roll-Off receiving prizes or prize monies. The prizes or prize monies will be determined based on total paid entries minus all tournament expenses and will be based on the USBC's neutral based payout formula.
- e. High Individual prizes will be in the form of gift certificates to Midway Lanes and will be purchased from entry fees collected. The prizes awarded will be as follows:
 - i. Male individual Prizes
 1. High Handicap game = \$20
 2. High Scratch Game = \$20
 3. High Handicap Series = \$20
 4. High Scratch Series = \$20
 5. Low Scratch Game = \$10
 6. Low Scratch Series = \$10
 - ii. Female individual Prizes
 1. High Handicap game = \$20
 2. High Scratch Game = \$20
 3. High Handicap Series = \$20
 4. High Scratch Series = \$20
 5. Low Scratch Game = \$10
 6. Low Scratch Series = \$10

- f. Individual handicaps will be established at the maximum of 100 pins for individuals who do not have an established handicap either on record with Midway Lanes or with the USBC.
 - i. If a bowler has no average they must report the first two games to the tournament director to verify their pin count and for necessary handicap adjustments.
 - 1. Adjustments will be made only if the first two games handicap would be less than 100 pins.
 - 2. All established bowling averages will have handicap based on 100% of 200 pins.
 - a. Example an individual that has a 150 pin average would have a 50 pin handicap. An individual that had a 200 pin average would have a 0 pin handicap.
